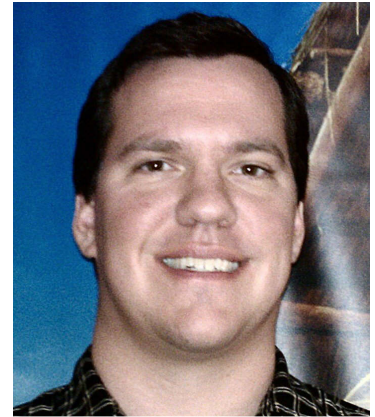


Rainbow Publishers' Editor Named to Conference Faculty
